IMPORTANT! If you are selected:

1. You will have to complete and sign an Application Form, which includes a Departure/Release Form, and a Waiver/Release.
2. You **MUST** complete a medical form, including a recent (within one year) doctor's certification. This is due no later than two weeks prior to the start of camp. If you do not submit a medical form, your child will not be allowed to participate in camp.
3. You will be asked to sign a photograph/use-of-likeness waiver, or to indicate that you decline to grant this permission.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Only one application for each child will be entered into the drawing.
